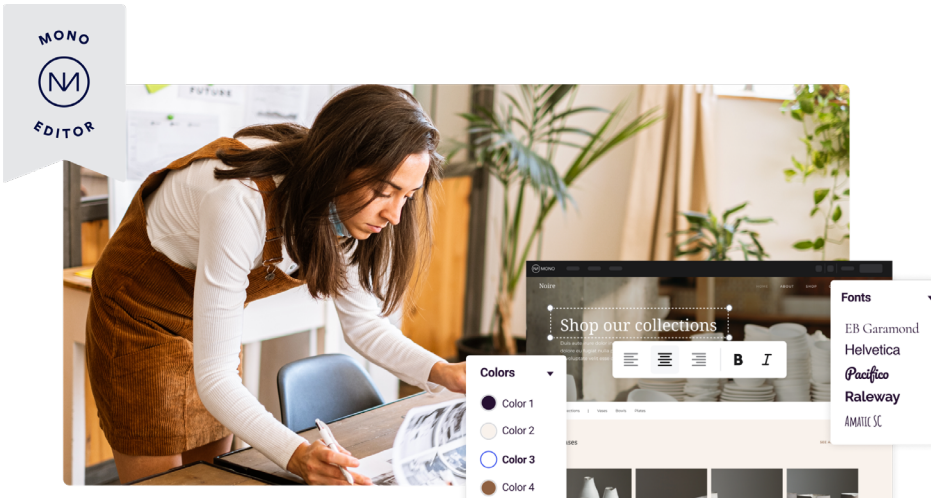

Workflow efficiency

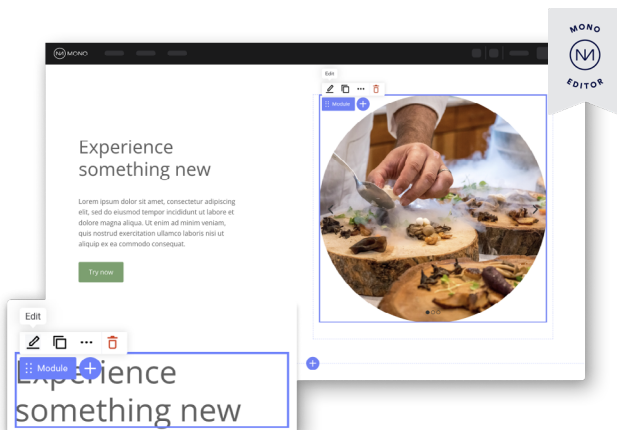
